

**Who can enroll?**

UI is open to Masters level students in architecture. In some cases we can make an exception, for example Masters in Landscape Architecture students are welcome, but may not be able to attain credit. If you are interested and think you might qualify, send us an email at [contact@urbanislands.net](mailto:contact@urbanislands.net). Enrolments fall into two categories: University Affiliated and Independent. For a list of Universities offering the course as an elective (University Affiliated enrolments), see the **Can I claim credit** section below. All other students should enroll independently.

**How do I enroll?**

If you are enrolling through your University, follow their instructions. If you are enrolling independently, fill in the application form (available for download from ABOUT section of website) and email to the contact email address.

**When can I enroll?**

Enrolments are open now and until June 1<sup>st</sup> 2011. Note that for Universities offering the course as an elective, the cut-off date may be different.

**Accommodation?**

UI do not organise accommodation, however we do have an arrangement with a local hostel called "Wake Up" (see website below). Their rates are between \$32 (10 bed room) and \$98 (twin room) per night and they will be offering a discount to UI students (sum TBA). They are located close to Central Station and a 10 minute walk to University of Sydney. The whole hostel has been newly refurbished. If you want to be part of this, tick the box on the application form and we will be in touch.

**What does it cost?**

Tuition:	\$500 AUD for independent enrollments Standard cost of a 6 credit point elective for University Affiliated enrollments
Accommodation:	See <b>Accommodation</b> section above
Travel:	In addition to your travel costs to and from Sydney, allow for a number of return ferry trips to Cockatoo Island (\$11 each).
Materials:	Very much studio dependent. The program allocates \$500 to each studio for materials and expenses. We would advise allowing \$100 - \$200 in addition.

**How do I pay?**

If you are enrolling through your University all payment is run through them. If you are enrolling independently and have an Australian bank account, you can pay via direct debit (details are on the application form). If you are an overseas student, we will contact you with payment options.

**When do I pay?**

If you are enrolling through your University, then all payment is run through them. If you are enrolling independently, we require payment of a 50% deposit in order to secure your place. Remaining payment is due on June 13<sup>th</sup>.

**Is the course graded and can I claim credit?**

Yes the course is graded.

UI is being offered as a 6 credit point elective at the following Australian Universities:

University of Sydney, UTS, Newcastle, Monash.

The following Universities are offering credit for the program, but students must enroll independently: RMIT, UNSW (tbc).

Students from all other Universities will need to enroll independently, and liaise with their institution personally about credit. UI will write a letter formally confirming your attendance and grade at the end of the program. We are happy to correspond directly with course coordinators to facilitate the process as necessary.

**What is the schedule for the 12 days?**

A draft student schedule can be downloaded from the SCHEDULE section of the website. This will be updated with more detail, but the basic dates and times will not alter.

**Is studio space available?**

Yes. We have been very kindly offered studio space and workshop access by the University of Sydney this year.

**How about work shop access?**

University of Sydney workshops will only be open to students who can show a valid certificate of induction. We are in the process of confirming what equipment will be available and when.

**What will I be working on?**

The program for each studio will be set by the studio tutor, and will be outlined at a presentation on the first day of the studio. Students research, design and construct responses to this program, usually working in small groups. Project types vary greatly. Prior student projects can be seen under the GALLERY section of the website.

**Can I choose who I want to work with?**

There is a ballot on the first day of the program to choose who you want to work with. We do the best we can to give everyone their first choice.
